<p>2026</p> <p>31st January</p> <p>Totnes</p> <p>c. £7 (+ £7.50 to visit the Castle)</p>		<p>Ancient market town, famous for its alternative living vibe ! We'll visit the Saturday market, with interesting antiques and world food stalls. And an optional visit to the 11th Century Castle.</p>		
<p>28th February</p> <p>Castle Drogo</p> <p>£16</p>		<p>The UK's last built castle. We'll visit the castle and gardens and take a walk down the famous Hunter's Path with views of Dartmoor and Sharpe Tor.</p>		

<p>21st March</p> <p>Bath c.£35 (+ £29 for Roman Baths)</p>		<p>The beautiful Georgian city of Bath, with its beautiful architecture, wonderful history and excellent shopping and eating.</p>		
<p>28th March</p> <p>Dartmouth & Greenway Mansion c. £30</p>		<p>Dartmouth & Greenway – A river cruise to the ex-summer home of famous detective writer Agatha Christie, visiting the house and gardens</p>		
<p>10th-12th April</p> <p>Topsham Music Festival</p>		<p>A weekend of music on our doorstep, in the lovely town of Topsham. (This event will be unaccompanied – Andy is away)</p>		

<p>18th April</p> <p>Exeter Chiefs Rugby</p> <p>c.£25-40</p>		<p>One of England's top rugby teams playing in the Premiership – international players and excellent rugby. A great day out with food, drink and sport</p>		
<p>25th April</p> <p>Lyme Regis</p> <p>c. £15 (+ £5 for the Museum)</p>		<p>Famous seaside town, home of the great Mary Anning – a pioneer of palaeontology (study of fossils) – part of the UNESCO World Heritage Jurassic Coast – and a great place for fish and chips !</p>		
<p>2nd May</p> <p>A La Ronde</p> <p>c. £13</p>		<p>A unique and fascinating historical house where you can follow the sun from room to room ! An architectural delight, set in lovely gardens and a great place for a typical cream tea !</p>		

<p>9th May</p> <p>Plymouth c. £21</p>		<p>Famous naval port and departure point for the Pilgrim Fathers, early settlers of the new world ! We'll do a cruise of the naval shipyard and pay a visit to the Barbican, taking in the Gin distillery and ice-cream shop 😊</p>		
<p>16th May</p> <p>Budleigh to Otterton Mill coastal and river walk c.£9</p>		<p>A visit to the lovely sea-side town of Budleigh Salterton. After a morning cream-tea/ coffee & cakes, a walk along the coast and up the River Otter to the old Mill for fish & chips and ice-cream !</p>		
<p>23rd May</p> <p>Castle Drogo by Bicycle</p> <p>c. £17 for bike hire</p>		<p>Visit to Powderham Castle, farm shop and gardens by bicycle. We will cycle the Exe Cycle track with beautiful river and canal views and a stop off at the picturesque Turf Locks pub.</p>
